SQUID GAME – Inappropriate Content

“Squid Game” is a popular TV series on Netflix, but it is not suitable for younger viewers due to its graphic violence and disturbing themes. The show shows intense scenes of death and psychological stress, which can be harmful to children and young people.

A number of children have been seen playing games from the show, although they may have not watched the series we have been stopping these types of games due to the linked connotations. If your child has been playing them, it is likely that a member of the safeguarding team has contacted you already.

We remind parents and guardians to be aware of the content their children watch. The series is rated 15+, and it is important to talk to children about the impact of such shows. Having open conversations about what is appropriate for their age can help keep them safe.
