- **BBC Own It** gives advice to children as they chat to their friends online.
- **Headspace for kids** is an app to teach children the basics of mindfulness in a fun way, aimed at 3-12 year olds.
- **JoyPop** is an app designed to help users find their inner resilience to deal with the highs and lows in their day to day lives.
