Healthy Relationships and Respect

At school, we work hard to help children understand what healthy, positive relationships look like. Learning about respect, kindness, and appropriate boundaries is an important part of safeguarding and helps children build the skills they need for safe and supportive friendships.

Healthy relationships are based on mutual respect, trust, kindness and good communication. Children benefit from learning how to listen to others, share their feelings, resolve disagreements calmly and treat others with fairness. These skills help them develop confidence, empathy and strong social connections both in school and beyond.

Parents and carers play a vital role in supporting this learning at home. Talking regularly with children about their friendships can help them recognise what makes a good friend. You might ask simple questions such as: *Who did you enjoy spending time with today?*, *What makes someone a good friend?*, or *How do you solve problems when you disagree with someone?* These conversations help children reflect on their relationships and understand that disagreements can be resolved respectfully.

It is also important for children to understand personal boundaries. Children should feel confident saying "no" if something makes them uncomfortable and know that they can speak to a trusted adult if they feel worried about a friendship or situation. Reminding children that they deserve to be treated with kindness and respect helps them recognise when something does not feel right.

In school, we promote positive relationships through our curriculum, assemblies and daily interactions. We encourage children to show kindness, include others, and celebrate differences within our community.

If your child ever feels worried about friendships or relationships, please encourage them to speak to a member of staff. As always, parents and carers are welcome to contact the school if they have any concerns or would like further support. By working together, we can help children develop the skills they need to build safe, respectful and healthy relationships throughout their lives.
