

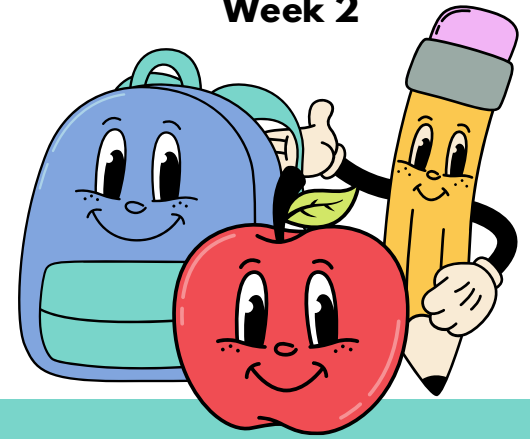

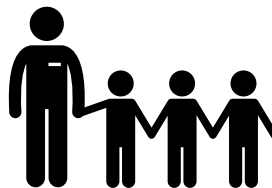

Misogyny

At our school, we are committed to helping children develop respectful attitudes towards everyone. As part of this, we talk about *misogyny*, which simply means unfair or unkind attitudes towards girls or women. While primary-aged children are still young, they may sometimes pick up messages—from peers, media, or wider society—that suggest boys and girls should be treated differently, or that certain groups are “less important” or “not as capable.” These ideas can lead to unkind language, exclusion, or stereotypes about what boys or girls can do.

We teach our pupils that everyone deserves to be treated with the same respect and kindness, no matter their gender. Through lessons, stories, and daily interactions, we help children recognise when something is unfair, stand up for others, and celebrate the strengths and talents of every individual. By building these positive values early on, we aim to create a community where all children feel safe, valued, and confident.

If you ever have concerns about something your child has said, experienced, or witnessed related to gender-based unkindness, please contact our Safeguarding Team. Working together, we can help children grow into respectful, inclusive young people.
