SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

If your child will be absent due to sickness, please inform us no later than 8.45am. If you do not receive an answer on the telephone, please leave a message stating their full name and class and the reason for their absence. Please advise the nature of their illness, not just unwell. Please ensure that you inform the school office using the above details, not just by informing your child's class teacher – teachers are very busy and do not always have time to inform the office before the end of registration and this could result in you receiving an absence message.

Please obtain **medical or dental appointments** outside of school hours for both your children and yourself. We do appreciate that this can be difficult, but please bear in mind that if children miss any time in school, this may have an impact on their education.

Breakfast Club

Our **Breakfast Club** is open from 7.45am to 8.45am Monday to Friday for children in Reception and Years 1 to 6. Children can enjoy a choice of breakfast items and a drink plus the opportunity to play in a safe environment. The charge for this is currently £3 per child per day and is payable via ParentPay at the end of each week. We offer a free breakfast to those children entitled to Pupil Premium funding. At the moment, you do not need to book in advance for this.
