Keeping children safe online is an important part of our safeguarding responsibilities. The digital world offers many opportunities for learning and fun, but it can also present risks. By working together, we can help children develop safe and responsible online habits.

### How we support online safety in school

- Children are taught about online safety through Computing, PSHE and assemblies
- Staff receive regular training on online safeguarding and emerging risks
- Filtering and monitoring systems are in place on school devices and networks
- Children are encouraged to speak to a trusted adult if something online worries them

### How parents and carers can help at home

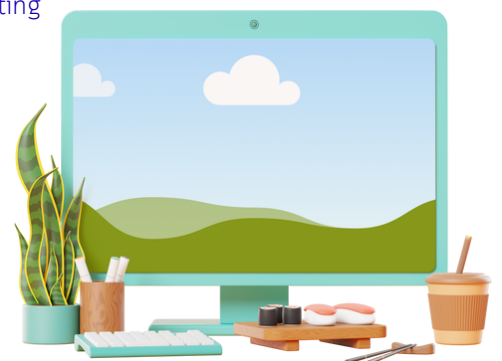
- Talk regularly with your child about what they do online
- Remind them never to share personal information such as their name, school or address
- Encourage children to tell an adult if they see or receive something upsetting
- Use parental controls and privacy settings on devices and apps
- Set clear boundaries around screen time and online behaviour

### Key messages for children

- Be kind and respectful online
- Do not talk to people you do not know
- Keep passwords private
- Tell a trusted adult if something doesn't feel right

## Children's Health

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) is reminding parents of the simple steps they can take to reduce the spread of stomach bugs and winter illnesses.

### Teaching good hygiene habits

Parents are urged to encourage good hygiene habits in their families, such as hand washing and using a tissue to catch coughs and sneezes. Regularly washing your hands with soap and warm water for 20 seconds or using hand sanitiser when convenient, is one of the most effective ways to stop the spread of germs.



### Knowing when to keep your child at home and when to send them to school

Children are encouraged to stay in school or nursery with symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat or a slight cough (if otherwise well and do not have a temperature), but should stay at home if they are displaying symptoms such as a fever. If your child has a fever, they should stay at home until the fever has passed and they are well enough to attend. If your child has diarrhoea they should stay at home for 24 hours from the last episode. If they have vomiting and diarrhoea or just diarrhoea, they should stay at home for 48 hours from the last episode.

Stopping the spread of stomach bugs: Stomach bugs spread easily in schools and nurseries. If you or your child has diarrhoea or vomiting, washing your hands with soap and warm water, as well as using bleach-based products to clean surfaces will help stop infections from spreading. Do not prepare food for others if you have such symptoms or for 48

## **PLEASE CAN YOU HELP!**

For over 40 years people with learning disabilities and autism from all over Hillingdon have attended the award-winning Rural Activities Garden Centre (R.A.G.C.) in Yiewsley where they have benefited from horticultural therapy and social support. In a hastily arranged meeting on Friday, 30th May 2025, those with learning disabilities and autism who use the R.A.G.C. and their families were told by the London Borough of Hillingdon that it had decided to close the R.A.G.C.

Hillingdon Council's press release provided immediately after the meeting stated that it wanted to close the R.A.G.C.'s retail operations and re-locate the R.A.G.C.'s horticultural therapy to the Civic Centre grounds. On Thursday, 26th June 2025 it was decided at the Council's Cabinet meeting to close the R.A.G.C.'s retail operation.

In order to protect the R.A.G.C. in June 2025 the Friends of R.A.G.C. submitted two nominations to Hillingdon Council to register the R.A.G.C. and its adjacent land as an Asset of Community Value (A.C.V.). However, the Council failed to meet its statutory obligations under the Localism Act 2011 to process the Friends of R.A.G.C.'s nominations within the eight-week legal deadline.

The Friends of R.A.G.C. are now seeking to raise **£9,750 by Wednesday, 14th January 2026** to support its judicial review proceedings against Hillingdon Council in order to protect the R.A.G.C. for current and future generations of those with learning disabilities and autism in Hillingdon.
