This week the children marked 'Anti-Bullying Week'. We celebrated by wearing our odd socks to acknowledge that we all have differences and that this should be celebrated. During PSHE lessons, the children explored the differences between conflict and bullying. Teachers shared the same message that bullying is repeated, intentional unkind behaviour that hurts someone physically or emotionally. All Laurel Lane, children are taught the "Say, Stop, Tell" strategy: say what's happening, walk away to stop the situation and tell a trusted adult. During sessions, children are also encouraged not to be a 'bystander' and to speak up in support of others too. At Laurel Lane we are committed to creating a safe and supportive community and do not tolerate any form of bullying.
