## Safeguarding Information

Pupils and staff at Laurel Lane have been exploring risks associated with being online. Online bullying is a topic that is discussed throughout the school to ensure that pupils are equipped when using the Internet or apps. Potential signs to observe, which may indicate that there are concerns, include but are not limited to:

- increased anxiety, depression or low self-esteem
- social withdrawal or isolation
- physical symptoms like headaches or stomach aches
- decreased school performance

Key strategies suggested to support pupils include:

- promoting an open dialogue where children feel comfortable discussing online issues
- recognising the signs
- instructing children not to retaliate and save any evidence
- teach children reporting mechanisms including the 'report' and 'block' function
- encourage children to share their concerns
- involve authorities if necessary
