BULLYING

All allegations of bullying are taken very seriously and are carefully investigated, as bullying is a safeguarding issue.

Bullying is defined as behaviour that is **repeated, intentional, and involves an imbalance of power**, where a child or group of children regularly causes harm to another. This harm may be physical, verbal, emotional, or take place online, and over time it can significantly impact a child's wellbeing, confidence, and sense of safety.

While one-off incidents of unkindness or disagreement are not usually considered bullying, repeated behaviours that cause distress and make a child feel unsafe require a safeguarding response. We are committed to providing appropriate pastoral support for both the child experiencing bullying and the child displaying the behaviour, and we work closely with families to ensure concerns are addressed openly, consistently, and in the best interests of all children involved.

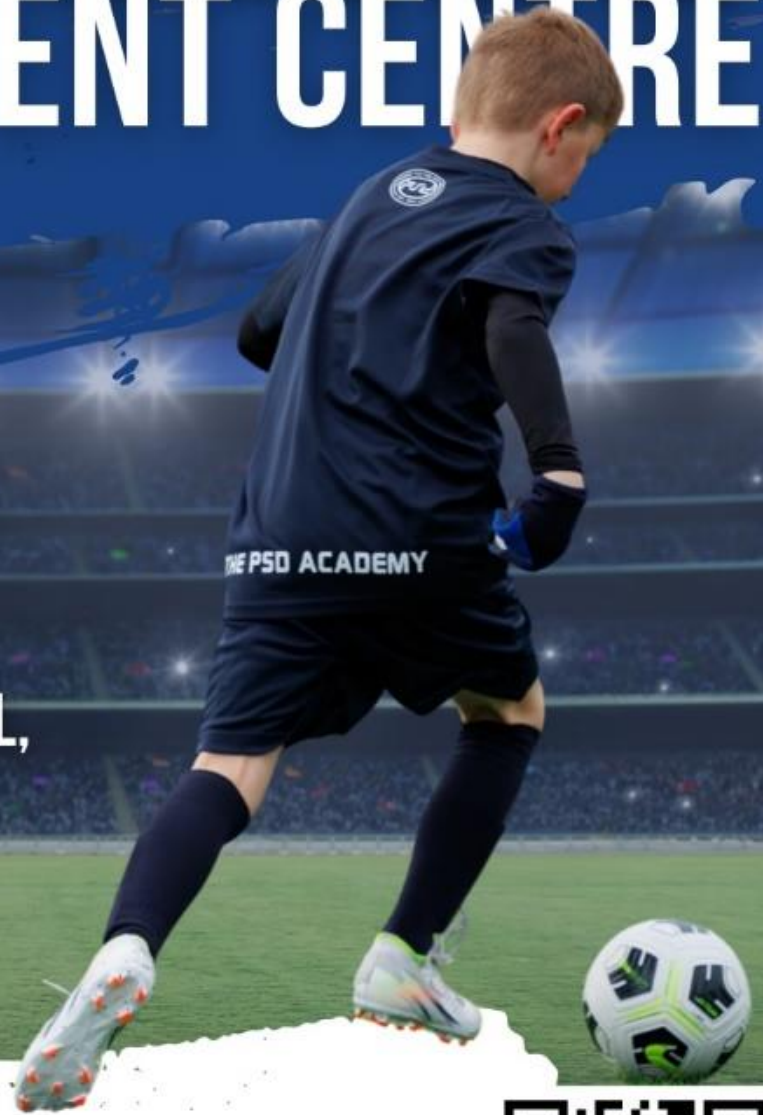
