Chatbots

As a school we are becoming increasingly more aware of children engaging with 'chatbots'. Chatbots are computer programs that can "talk" to users by answering questions or holding conversations. They are now built into many websites, apps and games that children may access at home, including Snapchat, WhatsApp, Facebook and Instagram. While some chatbots are designed to be helpful, they are not always safe or suitable for children.

Potential risks include:

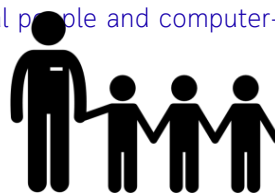
- Inappropriate responses: Chatbots may generate language or topics that are not suitable for children
- Misinformation: Chatbots do not always provide correct answers and may present false information as fact
- Privacy concerns: Children may be encouraged to share personal details without realising the risks
- Lack of understanding: Chatbots cannot recognise emotions or know when a child is confused, worried or unsafe

In school, we teach pupils to:

- Never use chatbots without adult permission
- Avoid sharing personal information online
- Speak to a trusted adult if something online makes them feel uncomfortable or confused

We ask parents and carers to help by:

- Checking which apps and websites your child uses
- Supervising online activity and using parental controls
- Talking to children about the difference between real people and computer-generated responses

- 6 regularly scheduled drop-in sessions - no expectation to attend every one
- Group members may vary each session
