Online Safety and Peer Influence

Children are spending increasing amounts of time online, which can bring both opportunities and risks. We are seeing nationally that friendships, behaviour, and worries can sometimes be influenced by what children see and share online. It is important that children understand how to stay safe, make positive choices, and speak to a trusted adult if something makes them feel uncomfortable or unsure. We encourage families to talk regularly with their child about their online activity, including the games they play, what they are watching, and who they are communicating with. By working together, we can help children navigate the online world safely and confidently.

Top 3 Tips for Parents

- Keep conversations open – Ask your child about what they enjoy online and remind them they can always talk to you if something worries them.
- Use shared spaces and boundaries – Where possible, keep devices in family areas and set clear rules around screen time and appropriate content.
- Know platforms and controls – Check age ratings, privacy settings, and parental controls to help keep your child safe online.
