Request for tissues

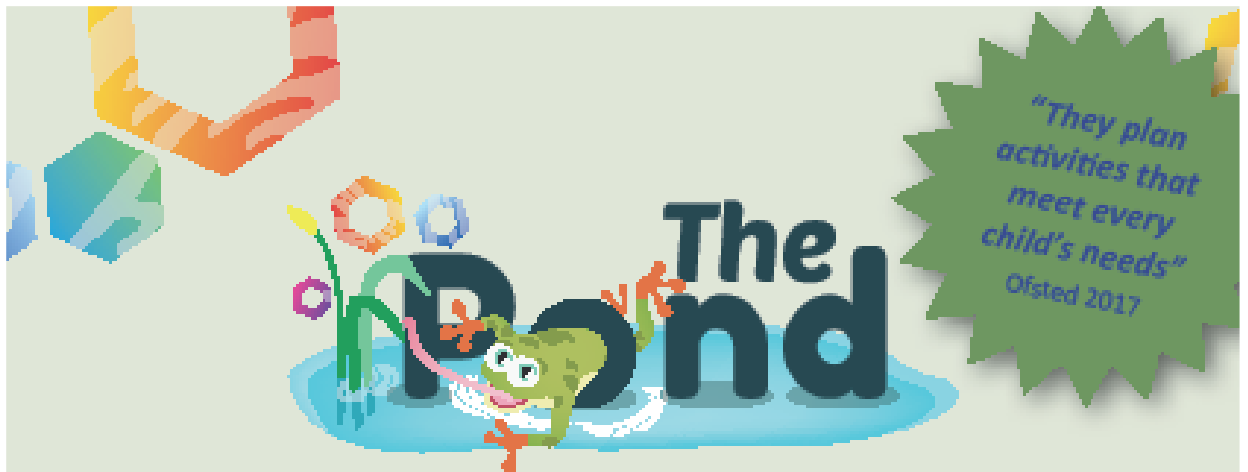
In order to help us, can you please donate a box of tissues to your child's class so that we can all be sure that they are able to keep their noses clean and dry so that they don't get sore. Thank you

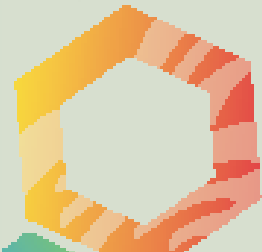
