
### Top Tip for engaging in your child's education

### The Importance of Bike Helmets

Unfortunately accidents do happen. Every year children are taken to hospital with injuries caused from riding a bike and a lot of these are head injuries caused from riding a bike and a lot of these are head injuries which is why helmets are so important.

Establish the helmet habit early when children start their cycling journey with you. If they learn to wear helmets whenever they ride it will become a habit for a lifetime.

There are important points to remember:-

- Make sure the helmet fits the child
- Ensure the helmet is put on the correct way round
- Treat the helmet with care – if damaged it wont protect the child as well when you need it
- If a child falls off, replace the helmet

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
