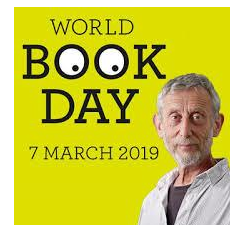


World Book Day – Thursday 7th March 2019
