We had a great "World Book Day" in school on Thursday. The children and staff looked fabulous dressed as their favourite characters and numbers. They also took part in a variety of activities in class. The children received a £1.00 book token to contribute towards a new book – we hope that they enjoy their reading.

Unfortunately we seem to have a few cases of head lice and diarrhoea in the school. Both of these can be easily caught, especially by younger children who are far too busy having fun and forget about washing their hands after going to the toilet and, in the case of head lice, by being in close contact. In order to try to stop these spreading further, can you please check your child for head lice and treat them if necessary (there is no need to keep them away from school once the first treatment has been given). In the case of diarrhoea, teach them that they should use soap and water to wash their hands every time they visit the toilet or after playing. If your child has diarrhoea they should stay away from school for 48 hours after the last episode.

Science day is on Friday 15th March. The children will be given the opportunity to create an outdoor garden. Each class are going to have the chance to design and make their own bedding boxes, deciding to either grow fruits and vegetables or flowers. They will learn about how to grow and look after them. The children will then spend the rest of the day focusing on how we can work scientifically and will take part in lots of different fun science activities.
