

This year's SEND Family Support's Santa's Grotto & Christmas Market will be at Oak Wood School, Sutton Court Road, Uxbridge, UB10 9HT. On Saturday 9th December, from 1pm to 5pm.

For families caring for children & young adults with SEND (special educational needs & disabilities) and their siblings accompanied by their parent/carers to the fifth annual SEND Family Support's Santa's Grotto & Christmas Market 2023.

Entrance to the Christmas Market Only is free but there will be charges for using the Bouncy Castles and other attractions/stalls. You can purchase all day Bouncy Castle Access Passes in advance too. Access Passes will be given by the SEND Family Support's sign in table on the day.
