## **Pupil Absence & Appointments**

You will be receiving absence notifications via IRIS Software Group.

IRIS Reach provides contact numbers that are unique to our school, these are:

- Absence Alert Text Number 07908677175: Please use this mobile number to send absence text and reply to absence alerts by text.
- Absence Hotline Number 08448362095: this should be used for calls only. Parents can press option 1 to leave an automated message.

Automated Absence Call – Once answered an automated message will prompt you to answer questions relating to your child's absence.

**Appointments** – We understand that it can be difficult to get a G.P appointment at the best of times but please try to obtain appointments for yourself or your child outside of school hours. Being late into school or leaving early disrupts their day and can hinder their learning. We will require evidence of the appointment if it falls within the school day or the absence cannot be authorised.

**Sickness** – If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea, please do not send them into school. Please allow 24 hours after the vomiting has stopped before they return and 48 hours for diarrhoea. Because it can be difficult to obtain a G.P appointment, you might find that your local pharmacy (chemist) can offer help and over the counter medications that could save you from needing a doctor.

Medication in school – If your child requires medication more than 3 times a day, please bring it to the main school office to hand over the medicine and complete a permission form. Please do not give the medication to the class teacher and under no circumstances should you allow your child to bring medication to school themselves. 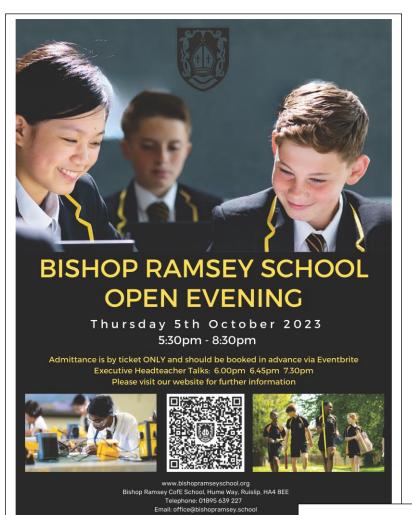

## Hillingdon Court Park



Set on the western edge of Hillingdon borough in Hillingdon West, Hillingdon Court Park is well used and vibrant, welcoming people of all ages in from the surrounding areas to the much appreciated and pleasant local site of pastime.

The site incorporates other features (horticultural/ornamental) into its mainly recreational setting, serving the community well with a play area, football pitches, tennis courts and sports, as well as a woodland area, conservation areas and formal gardens. There is a footpath that connects the car park, bowling green, formal gardens, tennis court and playground.

#### **Address**

Parkway, Hillingdon, Uxbridge UB109JX

**Facilities:**Bowling green, Car park, Childrens playground, Formal gardens, Outdoor gym, Sports pavilion, Tennis courts, Two junior sized football pitches

#### How to get there

Pedestrian access: Main entrance is east of the park, accessed from Parkway (off Long Lane).

#### Other entrances:

South eastern area of the park off Court Drive near the Park Lodge Sweetcroft Lane in the north of the Park. Portman gardens, Chestwood Grove, Sylvana Close

Car: Access from Parkway off Long Lane where there is a car park.

Public transport: Buses - U2

Trains - Hillingdon Tube Station (approx one mile)
