Pupil Absence & Appointments

You will be receiving absence notifications via IRIS Software Group.
IRIS Reach provides contact numbers that are unique to our school, these are:

- Absence Alert Text Number 07908677175** : Please use this mobile number to send absence text and reply to absence alerts by text.
- Absence Hotline Number 08448362095** : this should be used for **calls** only.
Parents can press option 1 to leave an automated message.

Automated Absence Call – Once answered an automated message will prompt you to answer questions relating to your child's absence.

Appointments – We understand that it can be difficult to get a G.P appointment at the best of times but please try to obtain appointments for yourself or your child outside of school hours. Being late into school or leaving early disrupts their day and can hinder their learning. We will require evidence of the appointment if it falls within the school day or the absence cannot be authorised.

Sickness – If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea, please do not send them into school. Please allow 24 hours after the vomiting has stopped before they return and 48 hours for diarrhoea. Because it can be difficult to obtain a G.P appointment, you might find that your local pharmacy (chemist) can offer help and over the counter medications that could save you from needing a doctor.

Medication in school – If your child requires medication more than 3 times a day, please bring it to the main school office to hand over the medicine and complete a permission form. Please do not give the medication to the class teacher and under no circumstances should you allow your child to bring medication to school themselves. 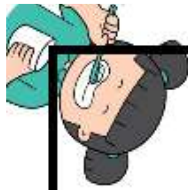
Autumn / Winter is coming.....

If your child has asthma and a preventative inhaler (Beige/ Brown/ Orange/ Red/ Purple/Pink) please make sure it is being taken regularly **EVERY DAY** even if your child is well as we are heading towards the most troublesome time of year for children with asthma.

If your child uses an inhaler or Epi-Pen please make sure that the school is aware by contacting Mrs Knight – mknight@fraysacademytrust.org

For children diagnosed with Asthma, we need a blue inhaler and spacer and for Anaphylaxis an Epi-Pen and (if prescribed) an antihistamine in school at all times for them – these will be kept in their class and taken with them should they leave class for P.E, assembly, school trips or anytime that they may be out of class for a time.
