Hooray! We managed to get through two days of sports day without any rain! Well done to all of the children who were able to take part, the Parents and Carers who were able to come along and offer their support, Primary Sporting Development for leading the sports days and organising the events and the Laurel Lane staff who helped and supported the children throughout the events. A special thanks to the Year 9 pupils from Vyners School who helped to run the events.

You may recall that we recently ran a series of fundraising sales for some of the classes. Thank you to everyone who donated towards these great causes, and to the children and staff for their hard work. Thanks to your generosity we raised the following amounts which will be put to good use to help the children enjoy school trips and playground equipment.

Year 2 raised an incredible £342.00 towards their trip to Legoland, 5CW raised £30.65 for playground equipment, and Year 1 raised £182.00. 6EG grew and sold flowering Daffodil bulbs for Mother's Day and raised £85.00, the proceeds of which have been donated to Marie Curie. Year 3 and 4 raised £350 and 6GR £222.75, both amounts were donated to the Ukrainian Refugee Fund.

It is unfortunate that the cost of living has increased substantially of late and this applies to schools too. Our running costs have risen, but our income has not, which is why we now have to ask for your support in raising money so that we can continue to provide the children with trips and activities. We offer our heartfelt thanks to everyone who is able to support us and make donations during these difficult times so that we can make this happen.

Talking of fundraising, we are pleased to announce the return of Year 6 fundraising sales for their end of year celebrations. They will be selling a variety of drinks (can's 80p, Fruit Shoots 50p) between 3.20pm and 3.45pm on Wednesdays (6GR) and Fridays (6EG). Please support them if you can.

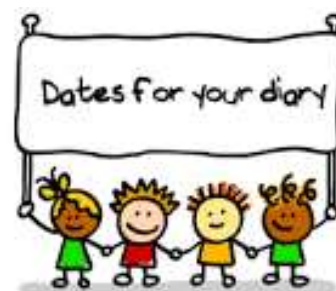
