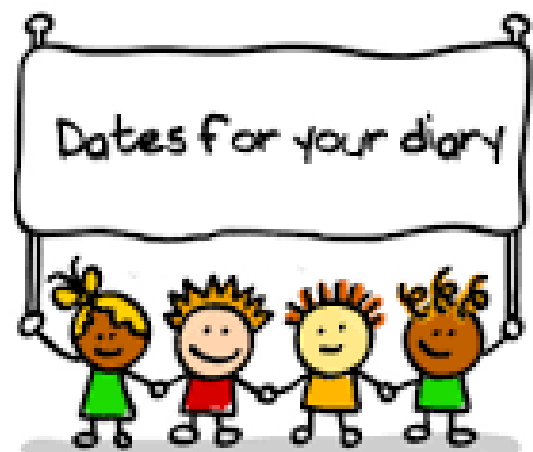

A crime has been committed at Uxbridge High School and we need your help to convict the suspect!

The Uxbridge High School forensic science team will be running a free of charge two day UHS CSI summer school. Over the two days, we will collect evidence to prove whether the suspect in question is guilty.



Activities will include:

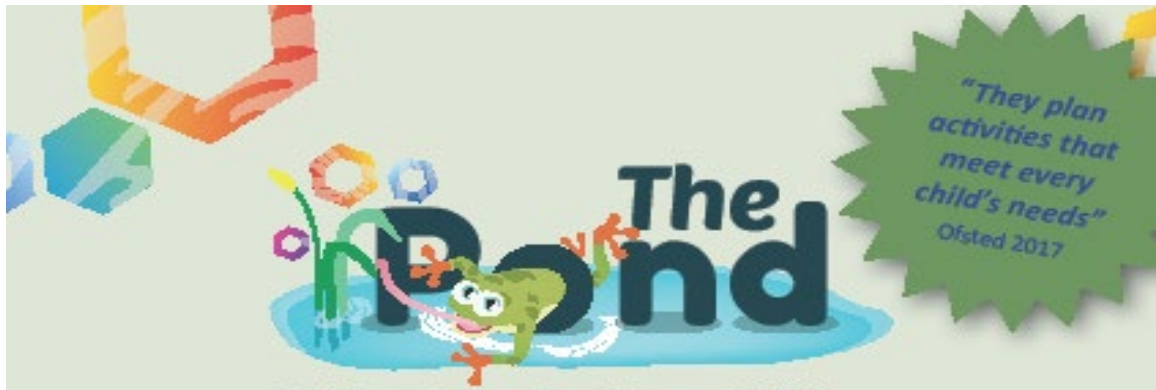
- Collecting evidence from the crime scene (overalls, gloves, overshoes and masks will be provided!);
- Analysing (fake) blood found at the scene;
- Taking fingerprints from objects found at the scene and identifying who they belong to;
- Testing soil from footprints found at the scene and identifying where it may have come from;
- Using microscopes to analyse hair and fibres found at the crime scene;
- Presenting evidence to a judge in an attempt to convict the suspect.
